



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- IV. To provide consultancy services and interact with the industry for development and manufacturing of Ayurvedic equipments including plantation of Ayurvedic medicinal plants.
- V. To collaborate with Indian and foreign research institutions and laboratories and other international organizations in the fields relevant to the objectives of the Sansthan.
- VI. To establish affiliation and collaborate with recognized Universities and Sansthan of higher learning within India and/or abroad to promote medical education and research or establish scholarship to support knowledge and knowledge based facilities.
- VII. To establish facilities for the practice of telemedicine.
- VIII. To establish all ancillary and incidental facilities required for achieving the objectives of the Sansthan.
- IX. To coordinate and collaborate with various hospitals/medical professionals for back referrals of patients for management of routine problems and follow ups near their homes.

B. Research

- I. To establish a core facility for research in Ayurvedic System of medicine and to provide a sand-alone platform for coordinated research for different agencies and researchers from different disciplines from across the country and also from abroad.
- II. To undertake, aid, promote, guide and coordinate research of a high caliber in basic and applied sciences related to Ayurveda and allied sciences.
- III. To provide and promote effective linkages on a continuing basis between various scientific and research agencies/laboratories and other organizations working in the country in the field of medicine, surgery, endoscopy, indigenous systems of medicine, virology, molecular biology, community medicine, biotechnology, physiology, pharmacology, immunology and related clinical and basic science areas.
- IV. To provide consultancy and interact with the industry for development and manufacture of newer technologies and drugs.
- V. To collaborate with foreign research institutions and laboratories and other international organizations in fields relevant to the objectives of the Sansthan.
- VI. To develop herbal gardens for growing plants related to various indigenous Systems of medicine.

C. Teaching and Training

- I. To establish comprehensive and dedicated facilities in the field of Ayurveda for teaching and training at the undergraduate, post-graduate and post-doctoral level.

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- 11 The training shall primarily cover the medical and paramedical aspects of various disorders in all age groups with special references to Ayurvedic System of medicine.
- III The training shall lay emphasis on the latest techniques and concepts evolving in the field of Ayurveda including allied sciences and basic and molecular aspects
- IV To establish affiliation with recognized universities and institutions of higher learning both in India and other countries for the purpose of enabling physicians and research scholars to register for post-graduate degrees
- V Affiliations from international Centers of Ayurveda shall be sought for recognition of work and improvement in the curriculum of training
- VI To serve as a Reference Centre for Ayurveda and to provide consultancy service to medical and paramedical institutions, public health agency and industry in the country.
- VII To develop the Sansthan into a deemed university with independent curriculum and degrees.
- VIII To offer professorships, other faculty positions, fellowships, research cadre positions and scholarships, etc., for realizing the objectives of the Sansthan.
- IX To organize teaching courses, workshops, live-surgical training programs, seminars, symposia and training programs of a specialized nature in the field of Ayurveda and related areas like yoga and Naturopathy.
- X To provide weekend training courses for various medical professionals, especially Family Physicians for early diagnosis, timely referrals and post treatment follow up of patients.
- XI To organize training programs for the technical staff in methods and techniques, related to the objectives of the Sansthan.
- XII To establish, maintain manage and administer the hospital laboratories, workshops, stores and all other facilities for the efficient discharge of model patient care, scientific and technological research in the field of Ayurveda and related areas.
- XIII To publish and disseminate information relating to results of new developments and research

D. TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT

The Sansthan, in collaboration with technical experts, researchers and reputed industrial houses shall guide and coordinate indigenous growth and development of modern technology equipments to make the same easily available, affordable and maintainable for those in Delhi or elsewhere in the country in the larger public interest.

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To receive monetary assistance from foreign sources including international organizations for training programs, scientific research and other activities

- F. To acquire by gift, purchase exchange lease hire or otherwise, howsoever, any property movable and / immovable and to construct, improve, alter, demolish or repair building and structures in any part of India or overseas as may be necessary or convenient for carrying out the activities of the Sansthan/Sansthan.
- G. To draw, accept, make and endorse, discounts and negotiate promissory notes, bills of exchange, cheques or other negotiable instruments for the purpose of the Sansthan.
- H. To enter into any agreement with any government or authority, Indian or overseas, to obtain from such Governments or authorities any rights or privileges, concessions, effectively or otherwise, to obtain and carry out, exercise and comply with such arrangements and rights, privileges and concessions that the Sansthan may deem desirable.
- I. To invest the funds or money entrusted to the Sansthan, to open such securities or to invest in such manner as may, from time to time, be determined by the Governing Council and to sell/ transpose such investment as deemed fit in the interests of the Sansthan/Sansthan.
- J. To do all other such activities, as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the above objectives.
- K. As a long-term plan, to develop the Sansthan into fully autonomous and self-reliant centre of excellence of national and international repute.

4. For the realization of the above objectives, the Sansthan Shall

- I. Develop and maintain proper campus of the Sansthan at the already established place at Ch. Brahm Prakash Ayurvedic Charak Sansthan Complex at village Khara Dabar, Najafgarh and at any other place as required in future with congenial and patient friendly environment at par with the best internationally acceptable standards
- II. Acquire and install adequate technology and competence at the Sansthan at par with the best established international standards
- III. Collect information and scientific knowledge in the form of books, journals, audio-visual and electronic material in a well-equipped and staffed Reference library of international standards
- IV. Provide technology transfer and technical service facilities to governmental and voluntary organizations in the formulation and implementation of programmes in the field.
- V. Invite representatives of Government, Universities, and other organizations in India and abroad and other outstanding scientists in the field to participate in the programs of the Sansthan
- VI. Appoint, employ and associate persons required for the purpose of the Sansthan permanently, temporarily, contractually or on honorary basis inter-alia to professorships, Associate professorships and

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Assistant Professorships, Research Scholars, Consultants of Society and to all other posts of various descriptions and to pay them salaries, wages, honorariums, fees, gratitude, etc. in return for services.

- VII. In one Sansthan-in necessary for promoting the objectives as specified.
- VIII. Issue appeals and applications for money and funds in furtherance of the said objectives.
- IX. Offer grants scholarships/fellowships, stipends, prizes and awards, in furtherance of the goals of the Sansthan.
- X. Make and enforce rules and byelaws and, if Necessary, to appeal, amend and alter the same from time to time.
- XI. Pay all costs, charges and expenses incurred in the promotion, formation, establishment and registration of the Sansthan.
- XII. Do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the aims and objectives of the Sansthan.
- XIII. Co-ordinate, guide and help the Government of Delhi, other Governments at the Central or State levels and other organizations in India or abroad to establish similar facilities in other regions by way of consultancy, technology transfer and through human resource development programmers of the Sansthan.

5. GOVERNING COUNCIL:

The affairs of the Sansthan shall be managed, administered, directed and controlled, subject to rules byelaws and orders of the Governing council. The names, addresses, occupations and designations of the present members of the Governing Council to whom the management of the Sansthan is entrusted as required under the societies Registration Act, 1860 (XXI) of 1860 are as follows.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION
(RULES, REGULATIONS AND BYELAWS)
OF

CH. BRAHM PRAKASH AYURVED CHARAK SANSTHAN, DELHI

Registrar of Society

1. Address of the Sansthan: The Registered Office of the Sansthan Shall be situated in the premises of Ch. Brahm Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan Complex in Village Khera Dabar, Najafgarh, Delhi

2. Definitions:

2.1 The "Act" shall mean the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (XXI of 1860)

2.2 The "Chairperson" shall mean the Chairperson of the Governing Council of the Sansthan.

2.3 "The Director" shall mean the Director of the Sansthan appointed under the rules of the Sansthan.

2.4 The "Governing Council" shall mean the Governing Council of the Sansthan.

2.5 The "Government" shall mean the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi appointed by the President under Article 239 and designated as such under article, 239 of the Constitution of India

2.6 The "Sansthan" shall mean the 'Ch. Brahm Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan, Delhi' registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

2.7 The "Year" shall mean the period of twelve calendar months commencing from first day of April and ending on 31st day of March in the succeeding year.

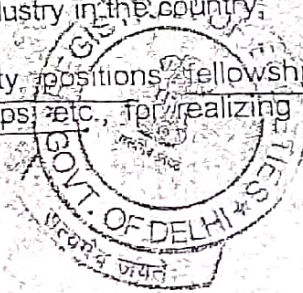
It is clarified that the words importing the singular number shall include the plural number and vice-versa if the context so requires and further that the words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine gender if the context so requires.

4. Powers and functions of the Sansthan: The powers and functions of the Sansthan shall be:-

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Registrar of Society

- 4.1 To establish, administer and manage the national level Sansthan of Ayurveda and such other centers for treatment, research, education, instruction, Human Resource Development, competence build up, technology development, technology transfer and other such functions as may be necessary for the furtherance of the objectives of the Sansthan/Sansthan,
- 4.2 To establish, and provide facilities for teaching and training at the undergraduate, post graduate and post-doctoral level in specialty of Ayurveda and other related disciplines like yoga and Naturopathy at the national and international level,
- 4.3 To develop the Sansthan into a deemed university with independent curriculum and degrees,
- 4.4 To determine and provide for admission of students/fellow, trainees to the Sansthan and to admit patients for treatment,
- 4.5 To initiate dedicated academic programmes like B A M S , MD(Ay), MS(Ay) PhD(Ay) and other such research/academic programme; where the country shall have the benefit of having well trained human resource with excellent clinical and research experience,
- 4.6 To establish affiliation with recognized universities and institutions of higher learning both in India and abroad for the purpose of collaborative research, training and exchange programmes for staff and students of the Sansthan,
- 4.7 To seek affiliations from international Centers/organizations of Ayurveda for recognition of work and improvement in the curriculum of training,
- 4.8 To serve as a National Reference Centre for Ayurveda and to provide consultancy service to medical and paramedical institutions, public health agencies and industry in the country;
- 4.9 To create professorships, other faculty positions, fellowships, research cadre positions and scholarships etc., for realizing the objectives of the Sansthan,
- 4.10 To organize teaching courses, workshops, live training programs, seminars, symposia, conferences and other such programs of a

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specialized nature through audio, visual, print and/or electronic means in the field of Ayurveda and related areas;

- 4.11 To organize training programs for the technical staff in methods and techniques, related to the objectives of the Sansthan;
- 4.12 To establish, maintain, manage and administer the hospital, laboratories, workshops, stores and all other facilities as necessary for the efficient discharge of patient care services and scientific and technological research in the field of Ayurveda and for other related areas;
- 4.13 To publish and disseminate information relating to results of new developments and research;
- 4.14 To fix, demand and receive fees and other charges;
- 4.15 To regulate and enforce discipline among the trainees and scholars and to take such disciplinary measures in this regard as maybe necessary;
- 4.16 To appoint persons as professors, associate-professors or otherwise as teachers, researchers & advisors of the Sansthan;
- 4.17 To provide for printing, reproduction and publication of research and other works in electronic or print form and to organize exhibitions for bringing awareness amongst professionals with the as in general public about various aspects related with the Ayurvedic System of medicine.
- 4.18 To determine the number, order and grades of pay of academic, technical, administrative and other posts, to create and abolish the academic, technical administrative and other posts, to fix the emoluments and terms and conditions of service of the employees of the Sansthan, and also to fix special terms wherever require;
- 4.19 To appoint all academic technical administrative and such other staff as may be needed;
- 4.20 To make rules for the conduct of meetings and affairs of the Sansthan and to adopt and vary them from time to time, if necessary;
- 4.21 To issue appeals for raising funds in furtherance of the objectives of the Sansthan; to receive grants, subscriptions, donations and gifts for the purpose of the Sansthan – provided that no subscriptions,

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donations, gift shall be accepted if they are accompanied by conditions inconsistent or in conflict with the satisfactory running of the Sansthan or conflicting with the objectives for which the Sansthan is established;

4.22 To interact with various forms of print and electronic media, other communication/promotional methods and with various social welfare organizations for furthering the aims & objectives of the Sansthan;

4.23 To sell, exchange, lease or otherwise dispose of all or any portion of the properties of the Sansthan, movable or immovable, on such terms as the Governing Council may deem fit and proper without prejudice to the interests and activities of the Sansthan; provided that for the disposal of the immovable property by selling, exchange or long-term lease, concurrence of the Government shall be taken.

4.24 To delegate, all or any of its powers to the Chairperson,

5. Teaching at the Sansthan:

5.1 All recognized teaching, in connection with the courses, shall be conducted with guidance of the Academic Committee by teaching staff of the Sansthan, and shall include clinical training, lecturing, laboratory work, research work, fieldwork and other teaching conducted in accordance with a syllabus prescribed by the Rules.

5.2 Teaching by eminent visiting dignitaries, scientists or professors from India & abroad shall also be imparted, whenever feasible. The Academic Committee shall function under the overall control of the Governing Council.

5.3 The authorities responsible for organizing such teaching shall be prescribed by the Regulations.

5.4 The courses and curricula shall be prescribed by the Rules and Subject thereto, by the Regulations.

6. Authorities of the Sansthan:

6.1 The following shall be the authorities of the Sansthan:

- I) Governing Council
- II) Finance Committee
- III) Academic Committee

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- Amended as on...
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- IV) Scientific Advisory Committee of Research Committee
- V) Public Welfare Committee
- VI) Such other Committees, as may be constituted as such by the Governing Council.

7. Membership of the Governing Council:

7.1 There shall be a Governing Council of the Sansthan which shall consist of not less than eight and not more than twenty-one members from amongst distinguished academicians, scientists, clinicians, administrators and such other persons as the Government may deem appropriate.

7.2 The following persons shall constitute the first Governing Council of the CH. BRAHM PRAKASH AYURVEDIC CHARAK SANSTHAN, DELHI:

8 Membership Roll

- 8 The Sansthan shall keep a roll of members of the Governing Council, stating therein their rank or occupation and address, and every member shall sign the same. No person shall be deemed to be a member or be entitled to exercise the rights & privileges of a member unless he has signed the Membership Roll.

If a member of the Governing Council changes his address, he shall notify his new address in the roll of Member; but if the member fails to notify his new address, the address in the roll of Members shall be deemed to be his correct address.

- 9 The list of members will be sent to the Registrar of Societies annual.

9. Meetings of the Governing Council:


- 9.1 The Chairperson shall preside over the meeting of the Governing Council.
- 9.2 In the absence of Chairperson, the Vice-Chairperson shall preside over the meetings of Governing Council.
- 9.3 In the event of both the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson being absent, the Members shall elect any one of Members to preside over the meeting of the Governing Council.

10. Functions and Powers of the Chairperson:

- 10.1 The Chairperson, besides controlling meetings of the Governing Council shall exercise powers of general supervision, direction and control over the affairs of the Sansthan.
- 10.2 The Chairperson may, in writing delegate any of his power to Vice-Chairperson or Director or both for the efficient running of the Sansthan.

11. Director:

- 11.1 The Governing Council shall appoint the Director of the Sansthan with prior approval of the Government
- 1.2 Tenure of the Director: The tenure of the Director shall be for a period of five years or up to the age of 62 years whichever is earlier. The term


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may be renewed for another five years, registered Societies of the Governing Council, subject to the age limit of 62 years.

12. Functions and Powers of the Director:

12.1 The Director shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Sansthan and would be responsible for the proper administration of the affairs and funds of the Sansthan under the direction and guidance of the Governing Council. He shall be vested with such executive and administrative powers of the Sansthan, as may be necessary or incidental for the purpose, subject to these rules and bylaws.

12.2 The Director shall subject to the provisions of these rules and bylaws and decisions of the Governing Council, exercise general supervision and disciplinary control over the staff and officers of the Sansthan and prescribe their duties & functions. All officers and staff of the Sansthan shall be under the administrative control of the Director.

12.3 The Director shall have the power to fix, on the recommendation of the Selection Committee, the pay at the time of initial appointment of an incumbent at higher stage than the minimum of the scale but not involving more than 5 increments in any case. Cases, where more than 5 increments are recommended by the Selection Committee, shall be put up to the Governing Council. Where ad-hoc appointment is made by the Director in terms of bylaws, he shall be empowered to grant higher start by granting up to maximum of 5 increments on initial of the scale. This shall be subject to the rules of the Government of India, if any, as applicable to the subject.

12.4 The Director shall coordinate and exercise powers and general supervision over all the activities of the Sansthan and shall also function as Member-Secretary of the Governing Council of the Sansthan.

13. Terms of Office of Members of the Governing Council

13.1 Unless the membership of the Governing Council is terminated as provided under the Rules and subject to the provisions under the Rules, each nominated member of the Governing Council shall relinquish his membership on the expiry of three years from the date on which he becomes a member of the Governing Council.

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But he shall be eligible for re-appointment. In case of a casual vacancy, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the remaining portion of the term of the out-going member.

13.2 A member of the Governing Council shall cease to be the member on the happening of any of the following events:

- i) If he resigns, becomes of unsound mind, becomes insolvent or is convicted of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude or his employer refuses to grant him permission to serve on the Governing Council.
- ii) If he does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Governing Council, without prior permission of the chairperson.

13.3 Whenever a member desires to resign from the membership of the Governing Council, he shall forward a letter containing his resignation addressed to the Member Secretary and his resignation shall take effect on its acceptance by the Chairperson.

13.4 Whenever a person holds the membership of the Governing Council by virtue of an office held by him (ex-officio), his membership shall terminate when he ceases to hold that office and the vacancy so caused shall automatically be filled by his successor to that office.

13.5 The members of the Governing Council shall not be entitled to any remuneration from the Sansthan Excepting the full time Director of the Sansthan. However, the members of the Governing Council or any committee appointed by it may be paid by the Sansthan such traveling allowances and honorarium/sitting fee as may be decided by the Governing Council from time to time.

13.6 A person holding the membership of the Governing Council by virtue of his nomination shall attend the Governing Council meetings himself in person.

13.7 The Member Secretary shall attest the signatures of all the members of a newly elected Governing Council and shall ensure that the said signatures of the outgoing Governing Council tally with the annual list as filed with the Registrar of Societies before 30 days of the succeeding month in which elections were held.

14. Vacancies among Members of the Governing Council

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14.1 Any vacancy in the Governing Council shall be filled either by appointment or nomination, as the case may be, by the authority competent to make such appointment or nomination and shall be valid for the unexpired portion of the term of the member who has left.

14.2 The Governing Council shall function, notwithstanding any vacancy in its body and notwithstanding any defect in the nomination of any of its members, and no act or proceedings of the Governing Council shall be invalidated merely by reason of the existence of a vacancy or vacancies in the body or of any defect in the nomination or appointment of any of the members.

15. Functions and Powers of the Governing Council:

15.1 The Governing Council shall be the principal executive authority of the Sansthan, and shall have the power to review actions of the Scientific Advisory Committee, Finance Committee, Academic Committee, Public Welfare Committee and all other Committees and shall exercise all powers of the Sansthan not otherwise provided for by the Rules.

15.2 It shall generally carry out and pursue the objectives of the Sansthan, as set forth in the Memorandum of its Association.

15.3 It shall have the powers, in particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions, subject to the provisions of these Rules and the byelaws framed by it to:

i) Consider the annual and supplementary budgets and reports placed before it by the Director from time to time, and pass them with such modifications as the Governing Council may deem fit;

ii) Create and abolish posts – the creation of the posts of Group 'A' & 'B' category is to be done after getting the approval from the Government of NCT of Delhi;

iii) Appoint the Director, Professors, Professor-Emeritus, various faculty members, consultants, residents, scientists, scientific/technical/administrative and other officers and staff of the Sansthan, fix their remuneration and define their duties and terms of employment;

- iv) Enter into arrangements with the Government of India, State and local Government, other public or private organizations or individuals for securing and accepting grants-in-aid, endowments, donations or gifts to the Sansthan, or mutually agreed terms and conditions, provided that such terms and conditions, if any, shall not be contrary to, inconsistent or in conflict with the objectives of the Sansthan, provided, further that for any such arrangement with foreign and/or international agencies, organization/corporate bodies, approval of the Government of India shall be obtained;
- v) Takeover, acquire by purchase, grants, gifts exchange, lease or hire or otherwise from Government of India, State and local Governments and other public or private bodies or individuals, institutions, libraries, laboratories, immovable properties, endowments or other funds and facilities together with any attendant obligations and engagements not inconsistent with the objectives of the Sansthan, provided that for any such activity involving a foreign and/or international agency or organization, approval of the Government of India shall be obtained.
- vi) Appoint Committees and Sub-Committees for such purposes and with such powers and for such periods and on such terms as it may deem fit, and dissolve/discontinue any of them.
- vii) Delegate such administrative and financial powers as it may think proper to the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and to the Director, as may be considered essential for achieving the objectives of the Sansthan.
- viii) Frame, amend or repeal bye-laws for the proper and efficient administration and management of the affairs of the Sansthan and in particular to provide for the following matters:
1. Preparation and sanction of budget estimates, expenditure, enter into and execution of contracts, investment of the funds of the Sansthan, sale of alteration of such investments and maintenance of accounts and their audit.
 2. Lay down procedure for recruitment of officers and staff in the service of the Sansthan.
 3. Lay down terms and tenures of appointments, emoluments, allowances, rules of discipline and other

15.10 Recommend the broad policies and programmes of the Sansthan and suggest measures for the improvement and the development of the Sansthan.

15.11 Perform such other functions as maybe prescribed by Rules.

16. **Proceedings of the Governing Council:**

16.1 Meeting of the Governing Council shall be held at least once in six months.

16.2 In the first meeting of the Governing Council, in every financial year, a report of the working of the Sansthan during the previous year, together with statement of receipts and expenditure, the

23.1 An Annual Report of the proceedings of the Sansthan and of all the work undertaken during the year shall be prepared by the Director of the Sansthan. This report and the audited accounts of the Sansthan along with the auditor's reports thereon shall be placed before the Governing Council for consideration.

24. Alteration of Rules:


24.1 The Rules of the Sansthan may be amended at any time on the recommendation of the Governing Council by a Resolution passed by a majority of the members of the Council with the concurrence of the Government.

24.2 A resolution passed by a majority, not less than $\frac{3}{4}$ th of the total members of the Governing Council, may determine that the Sansthan shall be dissolved forthwith or on such date as may be agreed upon and confirmed by $\frac{3}{4}$ th of the members present at the second special meeting to be convened within 60 days of the passage of the resolution for dissolution. Such a resolution shall require approval of the Government before it comes into effect.

25. Terms and conditions of Service of the Staff of the Sansthan:

25.1 These would be finalized in detail by the Governing Council and form a part of the Byelaws. These would be, by and large, comparable to those applicable to similar categories of employees in other premier institutions like the IHBAS, ILBS AIIMS and PGIMER etc, under the Government of Delhi/Govt. of India

25.2 The Governing Council may sanction special allowances to any person/category as considered necessary with respect to terms and conditions of service. The actual details of the pay scales and allowances including special allowances will be approved by the Governing Council taking into account the special needs and objectives of the Sansthan. Special privileges, honorarium, allowances, payment, etc. for specialists coming from overseas/other states would be permissible. The Director, with the approval of the Governing


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- 26.1 All contracts relating to the management and administration of the Sansthan shall be expressed as made by the Sansthan and shall be executed by the Director.
27. Suit by or against the Sansthan:

27.1 The Director shall be the appropriate authority of the Sansthan to initiate or defend any legal proceeding in the name of the Sansthan.

28. Applicability Clause:

28.1 All the provisions of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 shall apply to the Sansthan.

28.2 The Sansthan undertakes to adhere to the Societies/Registration Act, 1860.



**Pattern of Assistance Governing the Grant-in-Aid to Ch. Braham Prakash
Ayurvedic Charak Sansthan**

1. **Introduction:** It has been decided to develop a facility with international standards, which shall provide a comprehensive and most modern set-up for the diagnosis and treatment of all types of diseases by Ayurvedic System of medicine including Yoga and Naturopathy; an advanced Sansthan for dedicated research and a resource for advanced training in the field of Ayurveda. The Sansthan would provide world-class Ayurvedic medical care for patients at affordable costs matching with standards maintained by some of the best available facilities in the field in India and abroad. It will function as an autonomous body through a Govt. Constituted Society named as Ch. Braham Prakash Ayurvedic Charak Sansthan registered by the Registrar of Societies, Govt. of NCT of Delhi under Societies Registration Act- 1860 vide Regn. No. 62486 of 2008 dated the 13th June, 2008 to be known as "Ch. Braham Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan" with immediate effect. The said Sansthan is intended to serve as a 'role model' for health care by amalgamating the academic skills of the Universities, clinical acumen of the super-specialists, research skills of the international institutions, managerial skills of the corporate world and technology development skills of the industry.
2. **Pattern of funding:** The funds of the Institute will consist of the following:
 - (i) Grant in Aid provided by the Government of NCT of Delhi
 - (ii) Grant received from the Govt. Of India and any other agency within the country.
 - (iii) Tuition fee from students of the Sansthan
 - (iv) Charges for providing specialized diagnostic & therapeutic services.
 - (v) Project related assistance, donations, etc. from various bilateral as well as multilateral funding agencies.
 - (vi) For taking any grant from GOI or other agency prior approval of competent authority will be obtained.
 - (vii) The Revenue receipt will be adjusted against the next installment of the grant being released.
3. **Applicability / Pattern of Assistance:**

The Patten of Assistance will govern the grants-in-aid to the Ch. Braham Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan, which has to perform various functions enumerated in the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Rules of the

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Society. Grants to the Society shall be released for recurring and non-recurring items of expenditure.

4. **Grants for recurring Expenditure :**

Recurring grant will be given to the Sansthan to meet the net deficit after deducting the amount generated through levying charges for services rendered by the Sansthan i.e. on the basis of total expenditure and total income of the Society.


Recurring grant may be utilized by the Sansthan for the following purposes:


- (i) Maintenance of patient care, outpatient, inpatient and emergence care services, including purchase of all items of medical nature like drugs, medicines, surgical, consumables, reagents/chemicals, spare parts for medical equipment, etc.
- (ii) To meet the expenditure on salaries, wages, leave travel concessions, reimbursement of medical expenses, training expenses, allowances, bonus, pensionary benefits and other expenditure on the staff as permissible in the MOA.
- (iii) To meet the expenditure on contingencies such as building rent, property tax, electricity and water charges, stationery, telephone charges, maintenance, repair and running of vehicles, liveries, maintenance of all kinds of non-medical and medical equipments, furniture, security and housekeeping jobs, periodicals and publications, etc.
- (iv) For purposes of beds, linens, mattresses, dresses, dietary item etc. all items related to outdoor and indoor and indoor patient care and running of labs and research, teaching and training facilities.
- (v) Miscellaneous items of expenditure to fulfill the objectives mentioned in the MOA.
- (vi) All the existing economy instructions for procurement of some items like vehicles, furniture, photocopiers, fax machine etc will be valued and required relaxation of the economy instructions will be obtained from the competent authority prior to procurement of the banned items.

5. **Grants for Non- Recurring Expenditure :**

- (i) For purchase of equipments and stores, vehicles, computers, telephones etc.
- (ii) For modernizing existing facilities
- (iii) Manpower development

Proposal for expenditure for items to be procured under this head shall be submitted to the Governing Council, by the Director, in the following proforma:

- (vii) Utilisation Certificate on Form-19 A of GFRs in respect of Non-recurring grant released during the previous financial year.

6. DISCRETIONARY GRANTS:

- (i) When under the order of the competent authority an allocation for discretionary grant is placed at the disposal of the Sansthan/Society, expenditure from such grant shall be regulated by the general or special orders of the competent authority specifying the object for which the grant is sanctioned. Such grants must be non recurring and not involving any future commitment.
- (ii) Finance Deptt. GNCTD will consider the requirement on case to case basis.

7. OTHER GRANTS:


- (i) Grants, subventions etc. including grants by States/Union Territory other than those dealt within the fore-going paras shall be made under special orders of the Government.
- (ii) Finance Deptt. GNCTD will consider the requirement case to case basis.


8. APPLICATION FOR GRANTS:

- (i) The institute shall submit the applications for recurring and non-recurring grants including discretionary and other type of grant, if any, to the Pr. Secretary (H&FW), Govt. of NCT of Delhi along with necessary documents as required under Rules.
- (ii) All the Govt. of India's economy instructions and FD's orders on the subject are to be complied with. Further, the relaxation is to be sought whenever required.

9. MANNER OF PAYMENT OF GRANT-IN -AID

The amount of grants, both plan and Non-plan will be released by Govt. of NCT of Delhi in such manner and installments as may be decided by the Government, in consultation with Finance Deptt. from time to time.

10. ACCOUNTS

Ch. Braham Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan shall maintain all necessary registers / accounts as required under GFRs.

11. AUDIT:

- (i) Sansthan shall appoint a registered chartered accountant as auditor to audit the account every year.
- (ii) The accounts of Sansthan shall be subject to the audit of Comptroller & Auditor General of India and Director of Internal Audit of Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The cost of such Audits shall be borne by the Sansthan.


12. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (i) The assets created by the Society out of the amount received as grant-in-aid from Delhi Government shall not be transferred, sold, mortgaged or otherwise disposed off without the prior knowledge or approval of the granting authority.
- (ii) The Sansthan shall maintain all such reports, statements, etc. in respect of the expenditure met from grants released under this pattern of assistance, as may be prescribed in the MOA and by the Government.
- (iii) Before creation of posts by the Governing Council of Ch. Braham Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan, approval of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi shall be taken.
- (iv) The Sansthan may make such appointments of staff as may be necessary for the discharge of duties properly and efficiently as mentioned in the MOA. The salary and allowances for the same would be decided by the Governing Council of the Sansthan, in consultation with the Govt. of Delhi.
- (v) Finance Deptt. Govt. of NCT of Delhi will consider the requirement on case to case basis.
- (vi) The provisions laid down in GFR will be complied by the society that provisions contained in rule 209(iv) (a) of GFR that the Sansthan should ordinarily formulate terms and conditions of service of their employees which are, by and large not higher than those applicable to similar categories of employees in the Govt.
- (vii) Audited A/c of Sansthan be submitted to obtain the grants from GNCTD.


13. OTHER CONDITIONS:


- (i) All Recurring and Non-recurring grants shall be utilized on the approved items only and expenditure during a particular year shall be restricted within the budgetary allocations made by Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- (ii) Head of the Sansthan will be responsible for observance of all the codal formalities, the provisions of General Financial Rules, the terms and conditions of the grant and the directions/advice of Delhi Govt. while utilizing the grant.

- (iii) The Sansthan / Society shall maintain separate account for the grants received from Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Govt. Of India and other sources.
- (iv) To examine the financial proposals of the Society, a Finance Committee shall be constituted by the Society wherein a representative of Finance Deptt., at least at the level of Dy.Secretary, may be nominated.
- (v) The equipments and machinery required for the Sansthan shall be purchased only after obtaining approval of Sansthan.
- (vi) Original budget estimates and revised estimates for each Annual Plan/Five Year Plan will be duly approved by the Finance Committee as well as Governing Council before submission to the Government.
- (vii) The Sansthan shall observe all the instructions issued by the Finance Department, Govt. on NCT of Delhi from time to time.
- (viii) As per the provisions contained in Rule – 209(6)(ix) of GFR, the board shall be required to execute a bond in a prescribed format binding themselves jointly and severally to abide the conditions of the grant-in-aid and not to divert the grants to another institutions/organizations and on committing breach of bond, the signatories will be liable to refund to the President of India, the whole or a part of amount of the grant with interest at ten per cent per annum thereon or the sum specified under the bond.
- (ix) Assets acquired /created wholly or substantially out of the grant given by the Govt. of Delhi shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the authority which sanctioned the grants (Ref:Rule – 209(6)(iv) of GFR, 2005).
- (x) Any decision creating major financial liability on account of recurring/non recurring expenses for the Govt. of NCT of Delhi, directly or indirectly, should be subject to prior approval of GNCTD.
- (xi) The budget estimation of grant is to be segregated on revenue and capital head separately in to sub heads like “salary”, “general”, and “creation of assets (capital) “ as per latest Finance guidelines.
- (xii) The provisioning of budget for grant needs to be made on net deficit basis (i.e., total revenue from all sources – total expenses)
- (xiii) The Sansthan shall evolve suitable mechanism to maximize generation of internal resources so as to attain self sufficiency/self sustainability over a period of time.
- (xiv) The H&FW deptt. shall review the working of the sansthan periodically depending on the scale and nature of the activities/programmes/schemes being carried out by the sansthan so as to ensure that the objective for which it was set up is achieved.
- (xv) Sansthan shall prepare annual report every year giving the detailed activities of the sansthan, expenditure incurred in various activities and details about income and expenditure etc.



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The project as conceived shall be an unique institute imparting education and extending healing therapies in the health care system of Ayurveda and Yoga & Naturopathy.

Proposed to be set in a 94.27 acres site as already acquired for the purpose is away from the bustle of the city. This site is located in Khera Dabur, Najafgarh, Delhi. Amidst a rural setup where tranquility and fresh air is aplenty the primary needs for dispensing natural healing systems of medicine are met judiciously.

The Institute is to be developed in this area having a reflection of rural architecture with the surrounding low high greenery. This institute is to be established by Delhi Govt., which will provide social infrastructure and development of this area and will be a unique institute imparting education and extending healing therapies in the medicinal system of Ayurveda and Naturopathy.

Yoga & Naturopathy is a part of Ayurveda. Yoga is a purely an Indian contribution to the entire world. 
